COUNCILWOMAN JANICE HAHN ANNOUNCES NEW RESTRICTED RV PARKING ZONE IN SAN PEDRO

LOS ANGELES—Councilwoman Janice Hahn announced today that a new “RV Restricted area” has been added in San Pedro. New signs have gone up prohibiting the parking of oversized vehicles between the hours of 2-6 a.m. in the area bounded by Cumbre to the north; Western to the East; Paseo del Mar to the South; and City boundary to the West. Designation of these “RV Restricted Areas” comes after years of Councilwoman Hahn working to find a solution to RVs being stored on residential streets.

“Large RVs parked in our neighborhoods are not only eyesores, but also create a public safety hazard,” said Councilwoman Janice Hahn. “Since taking office, I have heard many complaints about RVs parking on neighborhood streets. It has been an ongoing problem and I hope that this new way of doing things will allow people to load and unload their vehicles during the day, but discourage the overnight storage of these vehicles on our streets.”

Residents needing to load and unload their RVs, can apply for permits to park oversized vehicles in the designated area for \$10 a day, for a maximum of three days.
