**COUNCILWOMAN GREUEL ANNOUNCES \$25,000 REWARD IN VAN NUYS  
DOUBLE MURDER**

*Kevin Deville and Saul Garcia were shot and killed in December 2007*

**LOS ANGELES** – Continuing her efforts to ensure public safety in the San Fernando Valley, Councilwoman Wendy Greuel announced today that the L.A. City Council is offering a reward of \$25,000 for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murders of Kevin Deville and Saul Garcia.

“Violent crimes not only affect the immediate victims, but they terrorize our entire community,” said Councilwoman Wendy Greuel. “We must engage all of our resources to catch these criminals. Two innocent lives were taken, and those responsible must face the strongest possible consequences.”

The men, both 21, were in front of 7058 Hazeltine Ave. in Van Nuys when the suspect(s) approached them and fired multiple gunshots. The suspect(s) then ran to a vehicle parked in the south alley and fled the scene.

Kevin Deville sustained multiple gunshot wounds and was pronounced dead at the scene. Saul Garcia also sustained multiple gunshot wounds but was transported to a local hospital before he died. The motive for the shooting is unknown at this time.

“If we want to make our city safer,” Councilwoman Greuel said, “we must encourage community members to get involved.”

Councilwoman Greuel hopes that posting a \$25,000 reward will motivate people to come forward with information regarding this senseless crime.
