DESCRIPTION OF CAMP: Griffith Park Boys Camp is located in the hills of Griffith Park, next door to the L.A. Zoo. Operated by the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks, the camp first opened in 1926 and became an all boys camp in 1951. The facility includes 13 cabins (sleeping 11 people each), restrooms, showers, arts-n-crafts center, archery range, swimming pool, hiking trails, wilderness/outdoor program, campfire ring, ball field, and a historic lodge and dining facility.

THE CAMPERS: Griffith Park Boys Camp operates year-round programs for the youth and families of Greater Los Angeles and surrounding cities. During the summer months, the camp operates a traditional residential camping program for boys ages 7-14. Our goal is to provide a memorable camping experience to all boys that attend. We graciously receive assistance from community organizations that share our goal and each summer share with hundreds of boys the excitement of resident camp.

SUMMER CAMP: Summer camp consists of eight(8) to ten(10) weekly sessions (running Monday-Saturday), consecutively from late June through late August. Each session has a theme with corresponding activities, and a weekly field trip. Camp days usually start at 7:00AM (raise & shine) and end at 8:30PM (get ready for bed).

QUALIFICATIONS

- * Male/Female, at least 18 years of age with a High School Diploma, or equivalent, and/or experience with children. Experience in camping preferred.
- * Experience and proven ability in working with and supervising children and staff.
- * Initiative and ability to create, operate, maintain and evaluate assigned program area.
- * Ability to relate to ones peer group.
- * Ability to accept supervision and guidance.
- * Good character, integrity and adaptability.
- * Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control.
- * Current certification in CPR and First Aid. (or able to have certification by start of camp)
- * Good judgment and sound decision-making skills.
- * Unlimited potential for acting silly and creating a fun and safe environment.
- * "Bag of tricks" for rainy days.
- * Never-ending supply of enthusiasm and motivational tools.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- * To identify and meet camper needs in an all day and overnight camp environment.
- * To design and operate a successful camp program.
- * To assist with staff administrative role.
- * To take an active role in the overall operation of a safe and fun camp environment.
- * To have fun, learn new skills and grow as a person (alongside staff and campers).
- * More specific responsibilities will be discussed during interview and staff training.
