## **L.A. CITY ATTORNEY ROCKY DELGADILLO SECURES TWO YEAR JAIL SENTENCE FOR MAN FOUND SECRETLY VIDEOTAPING MINORS**

**LOS ANGELES** – Los Angeles City Attorney Rocky Delgadillo today announced he has secured a two year jail sentence and psychological counseling for a Los Angeles man found secretly videotaping adults and minors over an extended period of time.

Marco Dominguez, 38, was convicted of four counts of possession and creation/duplication of child pornography following a two week jury trial. Judge John Martinez sentenced Dominguez to five years of probation and two years in jail. In addition, Dominguez was ordered to receive psychological counseling and must stay away from minors and locations such as schools and playgrounds. The sentence also includes mandatory lifetime sex offender registration.

While residing at the home of friends, Dominguez planted wireless spy cameras and secretly videotaped the family's minor teenage girls and their friends using the toilet and shower between Fall 2006 and Spring 2007. Dominguez also secretly videotaped the girls using a flashlight and camcorder while they were sleeping, focusing on their underwear and crotches.

Videotape and other evidence was found in Dominguez's possession during the packing stages of a move by the family. Evidence containing child pornography was immediately turned over to authorities for investigation. At trial, the evidence collected indicated that Dominguez had secretly recorded other adults and minors nude and had engaged in creating this type of child pornography over an extended period of time.

Results of the investigation against Dominguez were forwarded to City Attorney Delgadillo's Corruption, Frauds and Enforcement division of the Criminal and Special Litigation Branch for successful prosecution by Richard Kraft, Supervising Attorney of the Special Trials Unit.
