VERBAL MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that Council ADOPT the following recommendations, substantially as recommended by the Public Safety and Education and Neighborhood Committees, (Item No. 37, CF 03-0028) relative to the Board of Police Commissioners' decision to adopt a verified alarm response policy for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD):

1. CREATE a task force consisting of the Board of Police Commissioners, the LAPD, representatives of the alarm industry, representatives/interested members of neighborhood councils and community police advisory boards, City Attorney, Chief Legislative Analyst (Chair), and the City Administrative Officer to define verification protocols, create a public education program, suggest revisions to the Los Angeles Municipal Code with respect to Alarm Systems, review the verification policy in other cities, and other actions as may be appropriate.
2. REQUIRE that the task force be appointed within 10 days; and that the task force report the results of its review to a joint meeting of the Public Safety and Education and Neighborhoods Committees within 60 days. (Hahn - Miscikowski)
3. REQUEST the Board of Police Commissioners to schedule the recommendations of the task force on its agenda, after the task force has submitted its report to the Public Safety and Education and Neighborhoods Committees.
