



Newsstand Kiosk



The Newsstand Kiosk is a freestanding, powder-coated steel enclosure intended to replace the permitted, green, wooden news vending kiosks that currently exist within the Downtown traffic core. The Newsstand Kiosks are designed to match other furniture elements that are a part of this program such as transit (bus) shelters, and are being provided in a concerted effort to unify the various furniture elements that exist on our City Streets. The Newsstand Kiosks stand approximately 9 feet tall, and are 8 feet wide by 3½ feet deep (excluding the kiosk's canopy). The Newsstand Kiosk will have a single advertising panel on the side that faces traffic lanes, and will be provided to the existing, permitted vendors at no costs. Viacom Decaux, LLC, the City's provider of these facilities, will maintain the exterior of the Kiosks a minimum of twice a week, removing graffiti, providing general cleaning, and replacement if required; the occupying vendor will be responsible for maintaining the interior of the Kiosk.
