GENERAL INFORMATION

This application may be submitted by any resident of the City of Los Angeles at least 18 years of age, who wishes to become a candidate for the position of Poverty Sector Representative to the Community Action Board (CAB) of the City of Los Angeles Community Action Agency. Applicants are to reside in the specific Community Improvement and Planning Area (CIPA) they wish to represent (see attached map(s)). Applicants must apply for candidate status by submitting an Application for Candidacy. No write-in candidates will be permitted.

Upon submission, each applicant's application will become public information and may be reviewed as such by interested parties. Elections will be held in 4 to 8 weeks after candidate application deadline. Voting location information will be mailed to all interested parties and posted to the CAB website (when feasible): http://www.lacity.org/CDD/com_capbd.html

The candidate receiving the majority of votes will be elected to the available position. The primary vote winner will be the Representative; the secondary vote winner will be the Alternate Representative. The Poverty Sector Representative and Alternate Representative are to serve a 4-year term. Representatives to the CAB will serve on a voluntary basis, there will be no regular stipend paid to members for their participation in regular CAB activities. The elected Poverty Sector Alternate Representative will act as CIPA Representative for all CAB functions in the absence of the Poverty Sector Representative.

PROTOCOL

All individuals who apply for the position of CAB Poverty Sector Representative will receive a written response from the City of Los Angeles regarding the disposition of their application. The CAB and the Community Development Department (CDD) will review the Application for Candidacy for form and compliance with stated instructions and determine the eligibility of applicants based on this review. The address of the applicant and the addresses of those residents who meet poverty criteria who endorse the applicant will be reviewed to assure Los Angeles City residency and residency within the CIPA the candidate wishes to represent.

The Application for Candidacy consists of four (4) parts that must be completed in full.

CANDIDATE NOMINATING PETITION

The Nominating Petition must contain the signatures/endorsements of at least 10 people in poverty who reside in the CIPA the candidate is applying to represent (see attached map(s)). For the election, an endorser’s signature is considered valid, only if the person meets all of the following criteria:

- a. The person is a resident of the City of Los Angeles and resides in the CIPA the candidate is applying to represent;
- b. The person is at least 18 years of age; and
- c. The person is a “person in poverty” as determined by one or more of the following criteria:
 - i. the individual’s family income falls within the Poverty Income Guidelines (see chart below)

- ii. the family’s eligibility to receive Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF); or
- iii. the family’s eligibility to receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI).

It is the further responsibility of the applicant to insure that each person who signs their nominating petition is informed of the purposes of the Community Action Agency and the Community Action Board.

Each nominating petition will be reviewed to determine whether it contains the 10 eligible signatures. While it is not required to obtain more than 10 signatures, it is stressed that it is advantageous to do so.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the applicant to insure that at least 10 of their endorsers meet all three (a., b., & c.) above listed criteria.

LETTERS OF ENDORSEMENT

The applicant is required to submit two (2) Letters of Endorsement from community leaders as part of the application. Community leaders can be, but do not need to be, associated with the CIPA the candidate is applying to represent. Please limit each letter of endorsement to One (1) page.

The letter must be addressed to the City of Los Angeles Community Action Board and comment on the applicant's qualifications to assume the role of POVERTY SECTOR REPRESENTATIVE to the CAB.

Such letters of endorsement should come from leaders in the community, who are aware of the situation of poor people in the City of Los Angeles

The letter of endorsement must be signed and include the following information;

- Home or Business Telephone Number
- Organization (if applicable)
