- Assessment
- Possible Accommodations in the Workplace

The Workforce Investment Act (WIA) mandates the delivery of employment-related services to eliminate the barriers that keep adults with disabilities out of the workforce. Therefore, WDD is suggesting that at a minimum one front line staff member attend the training. Front line staff could include Disability Network Coordinators, Lead Case Managers or Lead Job Developers.
