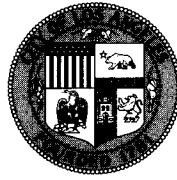

The Community & Senior Services of Los Angeles County has released a Request for Proposal for the General Relief Opportunities for Work (GROW) Program. They are soliciting qualified organizations who can assist GROW participants achieve employment and self-sufficiency through a structured program offering three hours of Orientation and three weeks of Job Skills Preparation Classes (Job club) four hours per day, including job search and placement assistance. In addition the county is also requesting proposals for innovative approaches to assist General Relief recipients find employment. Approximately \$10 million is available to private, non-profit organizations, and public entities.
