PY 2007-08 ADULT TO DISLOCATED WORK FUND TRANSFER

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Information Bulletin is effective upon date of issue.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to inform all WorkSource contractors of the request submitted by City of Los Angeles for a transfer of formula WIA funds from Dislocated Worker to Adult funding.

BACKGROUND

The Workforce Investment Act (WIA) allows the transfer of funds to maximize participant outcomes of the adult and dislocated worker programs. The City of Los Angeles has included a request for transfer of funds as part of the modification to the Strategic Five-Year Local Workforce Investment Plan. If approved, the City will transfer 30% its PY 2007-08 Dislocated Worker funding allocation into Adult funding. This action will result in allocating 73.2% of formula expenditures to Adult and 26.8% to Dislocated Worker funds for PY 2007-08.

TRANSFER OF FUNDS

Offer Sheets reflecting the new 73.2% Adult to 26.8% Dislocated Worker funding distribution will be forthcoming. Contractors will receive a letter the week of November 2, 2007, detailing proposed revisions. Although contracts will not be amended until the State approves the transfer of funds, contractors should be mindful of these proposed changes and may wish to prepare revised budgets at this time.
