**Subject:** Welfare-to-Work Directive 01-50  
**1999 WELFARE-TO-WORK ELIGIBILITY PROVISIONS**

The purpose of this directive is to remind all contractors that the Welfare-to-Work eligibility provisions were broadened to include custodial parents with income 100% below the poverty line. These new provisions became effective October 1, 2000. It has come to our attention that some agencies are not serving these clients. Contractors unable to serve them must ensure they are referred to other appropriate service providers rather than deny them service.
