Subject: **DIRECTIVE NO. 01-61**
LIVING WAGE ORDINANCE (LWO) RATE INCREASE

This directive is to inform all Workforce Development Division contractors who are subject to the provisions of the Living Wage Ordinance (LWO) of an employee wage rate increase.

Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.37.2(a) provides that the wage rates paid to employees of City contractors subject to the Living Wage Ordinance shall be adjusted annually to correspond with adjustments, if any, to retirement benefits paid to members of the City Employees Retirement System (CERS). The CERS Board of Administration has approved a 3.0% adjustment for Fiscal Year 2001-02.

Based on this adjustment, the new living wage rates, effective July 1, 2001, will be increased to:

- \$9.24 per hour without health benefits
- \$7.99 per hour with health benefits of at least \$1.25 per hour.

These increases are applicable to service contractors and their subcontractors that are subject to the Ordinance.
