PY 2001-2002 70% LOWER LIVING STANDARD INCOME LEVEL (LLSIL) AND
POVERTY INCOME GUIDELINES

This Directive transmits the PY 2002 70% Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) Guidelines recently published by the Secretary of Labor in the Federal Register on April 8, 2002, and 2002 Poverty Guidelines published by the federal Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) February 14, 2002. It supersedes LA City WIA Directive 02-03 dated July 18, 2001.

The Workforce Investment Act (WIA), provides for the use of two sets of data to establish whether an individual is a low-income individual. The specific measure used in determining this status is the higher of either the Poverty Guideline or the 70% LLSIL.
