There are two very significant reports regarding the operations of the Los Angeles Unified School District and how they relate to comprehensive educational and recreational needs of children.

One is a comprehensive audit of the LAUSD just announced by the Council of the Great City Schools which will be unveiled at the LAUSD Board meeting today. The other is a far reaching study recently prepared by the Rand Corporation.

The City has an obligation to review both of these reports in order to develop a better understanding of what changes are needed with regard to LAUSD as well as to better coordinate all of the City's recreation and after school programs for youth with the efforts of the LAUSD.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council of the Great City Schools as well as the Rand Corporation be requested to make presentations before the Education and Neighborhoods Committee as well as the Arts, Parks, Health and Aging Committee and the Audits and Governmental Efficiency Committee with the recently released LAUSD Audit and the Rand Corporation LAUSD study, and to provide copies, in advance, of their respective reports to each member of the City Council.


