

**RESOLUTION GOVERNMENTAL  
RELATIONS** **MAR 10 2006**

**WHEREAS**, any official position of the City of Los Angeles with respect to legislation, rules, regulations, or policies proposed to or pending before a local, state, or federal governmental body or agency must first have been adopted in the form of a Resolution by the City Council with the concurrence of the Mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, Former Los Angeles City Councilmember Marvin Braude passed away on December 7, 2005; and


**WHEREAS**, the late Marvin Braude was a visionary member of the Los Angeles City Council for thirty-two years and led efforts to create the Santa Monica Mountains National Recreation Area, protect Griffith Park from development; preserve the Pacific coastline, and improve air quality in Los Angeles; and

**WHEREAS**, he was also instrumental in the creation of the City's bikeway system and has been called the father of the Venice beach bike path where he was often seen bicycling with his family; and


**WHEREAS**, Senator Sheila Kuehl introduced SB 1583 on February 23, 2006, which would name the Los Angeles County beach bicycle path, which runs 22.3 miles from its northern end at the Will Rogers State Beach to its southern end in the City of Torrance, "Marvin Braude Bikeway;" and


**WHEREAS**, this naming commemorates the many conservation accomplishments of the late Marvin Braude.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, with the concurrence of the Mayor, that by the adoption of this Resolution, the City of Los Angeles hereby includes in its 2005-2006 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for SB 1583 (Keuhl) that would require that the beach bicycle path in the County of Los Angeles to be named the "Marvin Braude Bikeway."
