I-405 CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PALMS BRIDGE WORK

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close all lanes of the northbound San Diego Freeway (I-405) **nightly** from Venice Boulevard to the Santa Monica Freeway (I-10) on Tuesday, July 10 and Wednesday, July 11 from 1 a.m. to 5 a.m. in order to remove temporary structures at the Palms Avenue Bridge.

All lanes of southbound I-405 will be closed **nightly** from the I-10 connector to Venice Boulevard on Thursday, July 12 and Friday, July 13 from 1 a.m. to 5 a.m.

Detours will be signed.

The closures are connected to the \$167 million High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) project on I-405 from the Marina Freeway (Route 90) to I-10. The project is expected to complete early 2009, at which time the HOV lane on southbound I-405 will be continuous from the San Fernando Valley to Orange County.
