

## Sepulveda Boulevard Improvement Project Centinela Avenue to Lincoln Boulevard

### **PROJECT AREA**

The project will transpire along Sepulveda Boulevard from Howard Hughes Parkway on the north to Lincoln Boulevard on the south.

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The street improvement will include sidewalk work, median installation, sidewalk and median landscaping, installation of right turn lanes at strategic locations, and tree plantings.

This project will provide right turn pocket lanes and merge lanes on the eastern side of Sepulveda Boulevard between 74<sup>th</sup> and 78<sup>th</sup> streets, and the eastern and western sides between 84<sup>th</sup> Place and 92<sup>nd</sup> Street. The project will resurface and place asphalt concrete pavement at these roadway areas. Raised landscaped medians will also be placed at various segments of Sepulveda Boulevard between Howard Hughes Parkway and 92<sup>nd</sup> Street.

### **PURPOSE**

The boulevard improvement will relieve traffic congestion and provide three full time traffic lanes in each direction of Sepulveda Boulevard, with full time parking in the business district.

### **WORK SCHEDULE**

- Summer 2007 through summer 2009
- Mondays through Fridays from 7:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.
- A Holiday Moratorium that prevents any construction work on Sepulveda Boulevard during the holiday season will be in effect between November 16 to January 4 of each year.

### **TRAFFIC IMPACTS**

- Work will occur on only one side of Sepulveda Boulevard at a time.
- Two traffic lanes in each direction of Sepulveda Boulevard, in addition to left and right turn lane pockets, will be maintained at all times.
- Street parking will be temporarily unavailable where work occurs. Parking for business patrons will continue to be available at the parking lots behind the stores.
- The following adjacent streets will be maintained with at least one traffic lane in each direction, in addition to left and right turn lane pockets at the corners where they intersect Sepulveda Boulevard: 74<sup>th</sup>, 76<sup>th</sup>, 84<sup>th</sup>, 89<sup>th</sup>, and 92<sup>nd</sup> streets.
