GARCETTI RESOLUTION URGES WRITERS, PRODUCERS TO REACH CONTRACT AGREEMENT

Los Angeles – The Los Angeles City Council today unanimously passed a resolution by City Council President Eric Garcetti urging the Writers Guild of America and the Alliance of Motion Picture and Television Producers to continue negotiations to reach a fair contract. The resolution also offers free of charge City of Los Angeles offices as a neutral space for the parties to resume discussions.

“Around the globe, Los Angeles is synonymous with the entertainment industry. It’s part of our culture and it’s a big part of our economy. This strike isn’t just about the entertainment industry, it affects our entire city,” said Garcetti, who noted that a florist in the Silver Lake neighborhood recently expressed concern that a prolonged strike could significantly impact his business. “My colleagues on the Council and I want to be directly involved in doing whatever we can to help resolve this situation as quickly as possible.”
