



MOTION

Chapter 17 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code (LAAC) provides for the City to recover academy and training costs from Los Angeles Police Department Officers and Recreation and Parks Park Rangers who voluntarily leave these departments before serving 60 continuous months (5 years).

Training is also provided at the Los Angeles Police Academy to Special Officers hired by the Department of General Services, and Police Officers hired by the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) and the Port of Los Angeles (POLA). In addition, Security Officers hired by the Department of General Services (GSD) receive training at an approved police academy at the City's expense. Given the cost of ensuring that officers receive the best possible training in providing service to the City, similar provisions for recovery of training costs should also be applied to sworn personnel at these departments should they leave the City before serving 60 months of continuous service.

I THEREFORE MOVE that Council request the City Attorney to amend Chapter 17 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code to require that the City be reimbursed for academy and training costs from officers at the Department of General Services, Los Angeles World Airports and the Port of Los Angeles should they voluntarily leave City service before having served 60 continuous months following successful completion of such training, and within a year thereof, become employed by another law enforcement agency.
