CARDENAS INSPIRES MASSIVE NEIGHBORHOOD MAKEOVER ***Over 300 Volunteers Expected to Sweep Valley Streets*** ***On California Coastal Clean-Up Day***

Councilman Tony Cardenas has inspired over 300 volunteers to join him in cleaning up miles of streets and alleys in the Valley in honor of California Coastal Cleanup Day. California Coastal Cleanup Day takes place once a year throughout California and it usually includes only coastal cities. This year is special because Heal the Bay included Panorama City as one of the cleaning sites due to the fact that most of the trash accumulated at the beach, originates upstream.

The Panorama City Community Cleanup will kick off with coffee and refreshments at the Panorama City Recreation Center. In addition, dozens of city departments and community-based groups will help Cardenas sweep the streets, remove trash and bulky items, and knock on doors to remind neighbors of the city's free 3-1-1 bulky item pick-up hotline.

The Cardenas Crew will be picking up an array of tossed out items including rusty refrigerators, broken furniture, and old couches for free. No chemicals, TV's, or concrete pieces can be removed. **Residents living in the targeted area should put their bulky items on the curb before 6:00am on Saturday.** See map attached. All neighbors and volunteers are welcome and can check in at 8:30 a.m. Tools, supplies, breakfast and lunch will be provided.
