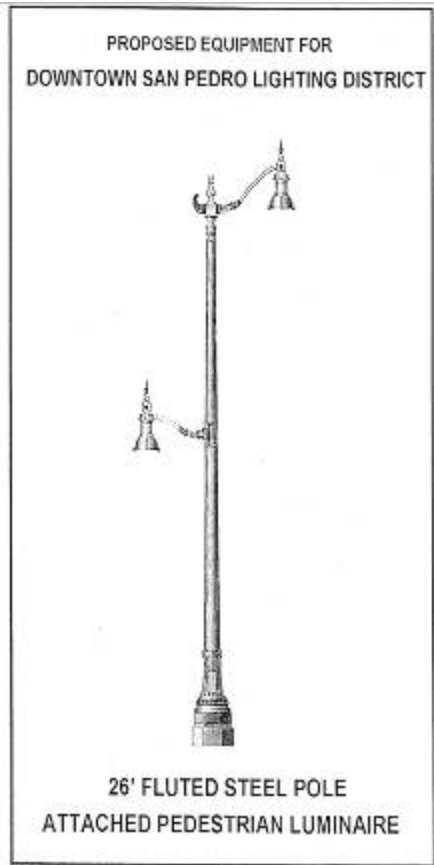


PACIFIC AVENUE STREET LIGHTS

between 4th to 9th Streets



Pacific Corridor Redevelopment Project Area

Project Description:
 Board of Public Works, Bureau of Street Lighting proposes to replace malfunctioning, burned out CD807, 150 wattage street lights with new 200 wattage decorative 1930's style Halophane 26' fluted steel poles, with special arms and fixtures. The lights will match new lighting recently installed by BSL on 6th and 7th Streets from Harbor Boulevard to Pacific Avenue. This activity required a Proposition 218 vote.

 Agency Board approval on December 20, 2007, to enter into an agreement with BSL for new street lighting.

Next Quarterly Milestone:
 BSL will submit to staff, drawing of streetlights for review and approval. Community is recommending replacement of street lights at other locations on Pacific Avenue and throughout the Project Area.

 Financial \$200,000, Leverage Ratio 1:6
