

Exposition Park Improvements

Redevelopment Area (Location):

Exposition/University Park (Exposition Park – Exposition Boulevard (n), King Boulevard (s), Figueroa Street (e), Vermont Avenue (w))

Project Description:

This project is part of revitalization efforts within Exposition Park and includes development of recreational facilities and upgrading of infrastructure in the immediate surrounding area. It also solves traffic and parking problems that could adversely affect the use and promotion of the park, if an NFL football team returns to the renovated Coliseum. The passage of AB 2805 by the California state legislature in 2005 allows use of redevelopment funds to upgrade the park to better serve the surrounding area residents and make it more attractive to an NFL team.

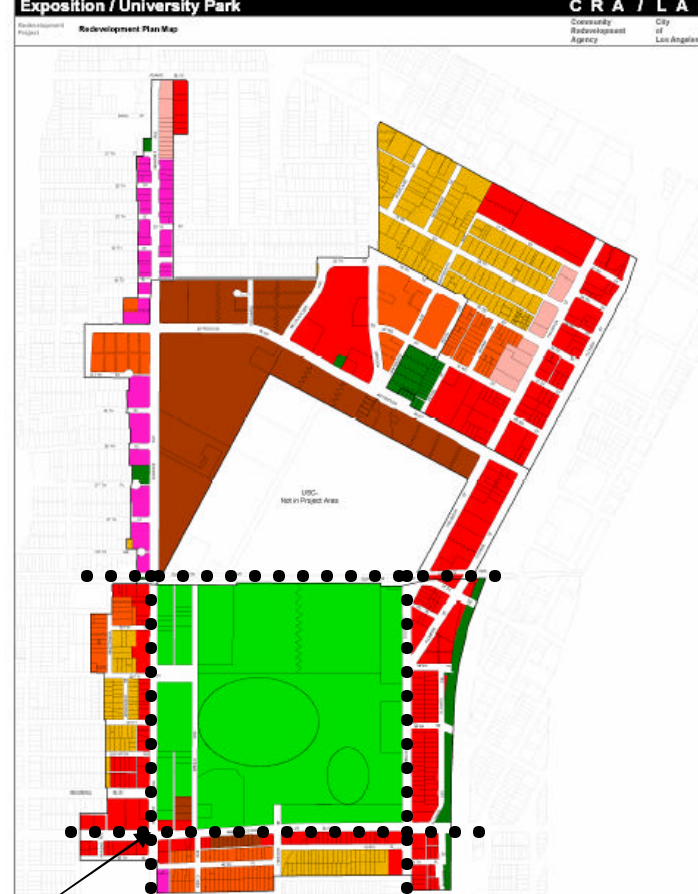
