CHICK FINDS CITY PARKING METERS WORKING OVERTIME

Los Angeles – There is a big change in how the City’s parking meters are collecting and keeping more of its change. City Controller Laura Chick has announced that the City’s Department of Transportation has significantly improved the rate of operating parking meters.

“Two years ago I found too many City parking meters were broken, and the City was losing millions of dollars in revenue. Today, my Office has found a 4% improvement which could result in more than \$1.5 million to City coffers during the next year,” said Chick.

“After my original parking meter report was released, a new and dedicated General Manager, Wayne Tanda, took the helm and implemented the recommendations from my survey. While there is still room for improvement, they’ve come a long way,” said Chick.
