SPRING INTO SOME SEASONAL FESTIVITIES

A variety of activities will be offered for children and families

LOS ANGELES – During the period of March 14-22, 2008 the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks will offer a variety of activities for children who are on vacation from school to enjoy, with some that are also for families.

Spring day camp will be held Monday through Friday, March 17-21; most participating facilities will hold their holiday event on Saturday, March 22, with activities to include visits from the Easter Bunny, egg hunts, coloring contests, arts & crafts, and more. Weekend carnivals will take place in late March or early April.

In addition to having plenty things for youngsters to do while they're on school vacation, many sites will also offer activities designed for children who aren't old enough to go to school.

Spring day camps have a fee and signup requirements. The times, cost (if any, and many are free), and registration conditions (if any, with the majority being open) for other events will vary depending on the location; scores of recreation centers and parks citywide will have activities, although not on all nine days.
