IT'S TROUT FISHING DERBY TIME AGAIN

Registration for 10th annual event at Hansen Dam Recreation Area

LOS ANGELES – Interested anglers can still register for the 10th annual Trout Fishing Derby at Hansen Dam Aquatic Center, a City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks facility at 11798 Foothill Blvd., in the Lake View Terrace (northeast San Fernando Valley) area, to be held Saturday April 4, and Sunday, April 5, 2009, from 6:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. each day.

Signups are being accepted on a first-come, first-served basis at Hansen from sunrise to sunset through Friday, April 3. The cost is \$10 for anyone age 15 or younger and \$20 for everyone age 16 or older prior to the event, and \$15 and \$25, respectively, on event days.

Youth can fish both days for \$18 with advance registration (\$20 on Saturday) and adults can do the same for \$35 (\$40 on Saturday).

Anyone can participate in the derby. However, those who are age 16 or older must have photo identification and a valid 2009 California State Fishing License. Children age 6 or younger will be allowed to receive limited assistance from a parent or guardian.

The derby is not a catch-and-release event; all fish caught must be taken home, and only one pole may be used at a time, even for those who have a two-pole license.

The event is presented by the Department of Recreation and Parks through its Citywide Aquatics Division, together with the California Department of Fish and Game, which will have a limited amount of equipment available to loan out (participants should bring their own gear).
