A GOLF COMPETITION JUST FOR THE GUYS *Registration under way for 92nd annual championship & handicap event*

LOS ANGELES – Registration is under way for the 92nd annual City of Los Angeles Men's Golf Championship & Handicap Tournament, which is sponsored by the Department of Recreation and Parks and conducted by the Los Angeles Municipal Golf Association.

All four championship flight rounds will be played at Rancho Park Golf Course in West Los Angeles, June 11-14. Jong-Yeop Lim won the 2008 tournament.

The two-round competition for net flights (for players who have a handicap and who will compete with comparable golfers) will be held June 13-14 on courses in Griffith Park.

The entry fee is \$150 for the championship flight and \$100 for the net flights (the minimum age to compete is 16); only checks and money orders, made payable to the City of Los Angeles, will be accepted. Registration forms are available at all city-operated courses and www.golf.lacity.org/pdf/tourn_forms/2009_mensEntry.pdf.

The Department owns and operates the largest municipal golf system in the U.S. There are seven 18-hole championship courses, one 9-hole regulation course, two executive 9-hole courses, two 9-hole pitch and putt courses, and one 18-hole pony course. The Department also operates one junior golf learning center - Tregnan Golf Academy in Griffith Park. City courses are open for play, conditions permitting, 365 days a year, from dawn until dusk.
