Register for the 83rd annual Los Angeles Public Parks Championships

LOS ANGELES – Registration is under way for the 83rd annual Los Angeles Public Parks Tennis Championships, which will be held June 6-7 and June 13-14, 2009, at the Griffith Park Tennis Complex, a City of Los Angeles Department facility at 3401 Riverside Dr.

The two-weekend event will consist of men's and women's singles and doubles, as well as mixed doubles and family doubles classifications (mother/son, father/son, mother/daughter, father/daughter). Players can compete against others their own age, or in the Open division.

The tournament is sanctioned by the United States Tennis Association and the Southern California Tennis Association, and is sponsored and presented by the Municipal Sports Section of the Department of Recreation and Parks.

The registration fee is \$35 for singles and \$40 per pairing for all doubles classifications. Checks should be made payable to: City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks.
