L.A.'s CITY MEN'S 92nd GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

Annual event will be played on Rancho Park, Harding, and Wilson courses

WHAT: The 92nd annual City of Los Angeles Men's Golf Championship & Handicap Tournament, sponsored by the Department of Recreation and Parks, played on Department courses, and conducted by the Los Angeles Municipal Golf Association. The Championship Flight will play 72 holes, all at Rancho Park Golf Course in West Los Angeles. The cut will be made after two rounds; the top 50 and ties will play on the weekend. Defending champion Jong-Yeop Lim is in the field. Handicap flights will play 36 holes at Harding and Wilson golf courses in Griffith Park, with one round at each course. More than 250 players in all are expected to compete.

TO GET TO RANCHO PARK GOLF COURSE: From the **405 (San Diego) Freeway** exit at Santa Monica Blvd. Take Santa Monica Blvd. east/northeast about ½-mile to Westwood Blvd. Take Westwood Blvd. south/southeast about ¾-mile to Pico Blvd. Take Pico Blvd. east/northeast about one mile to the course entrance. **OR:** From the **10 (Santa Monica/Rosa Parks) Freeway**, exit at Overland Ave. Take Overland Ave. north/northwest about ¾-mile to Pico Blvd. Take Pico Blvd. east/northeast about ½-mile to the entrance. (*Thomas Guide page 632, grid E5*).

TO GET TO HARDING-WILSON GOLF COURSES: From the **5 (Golden State) Freeway**, exit at Los Feliz Blvd. Go west to Crystal Springs Dr., then north into Griffith Park and follow the signs. (*Thomas Guide page 564 (grids A5, B5, and B6)*).
