

Los Angeles City Council Video Connection
A Video Conferencing System provides a two-way audio/video link
To Los Angeles City Council Chamber

The Los Angeles City Council Video Connection service is being provided at the Valley Municipal Building to enable public testimony from this remote location to Los Angeles City Council Chambers in downtown. A second remote site is under development at the San Pedro Municipal Building.

Please note that while best efforts are made to ensure the system is fully operational, it is recommended that testimony concerning time sensitive matters be provided in person at the City Council meeting.

How to use the Los Angeles City Council Video Connection Service:

1. Check in with the security guard, and follow the signs "Los Angeles City Council Video Connection."
2. Use the City Clerk phone to contact the Office of the City Clerk. No need to dial. You will automatically be connected to the Office of the City Clerk.
3. When the City Clerk's contact answers, please provide:
 - Your Full Name
 - The Agenda Item you wish to speak on
 - Whether you are for or against proposal, or have a general comment

Please be brief, as others may need to contact the Office of the City Clerk to use the system.

4. Hang up the phone.
5. Wait for the City Council to consider the item you wish to speak on. Council proceedings can be viewed on the television in the room. Your name will be called when it's your turn to speak.
6. When you are recognized by the City Council, address the City Council from the podium, speaking into the microphone.
