**Subject: SUPPORT FOR THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF IMMIGRANT AFFAIRS
(MOIA)**

The Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MOIA) was created to coordinate and promote the utilization of City services by immigrants and encourages full and active participation in Los Angeles civic culture.

The role of the MOIA is to be involved in policies and issues affecting Los Angeles' immigrant and refugee stakeholders, and to facilitate the access to City services, benefits and opportunities, as well as to ensure that the needs of our diverse immigrant communities are being met through linguistically and culturally competent service delivery.

All General Managers, Heads of Departments/Offices and Commissions of City Government are directed to designate an Executive Liaison to collaborate with MOIA. Executive Liaisons will work closely with the Director of MOIA and will be responsible for ensuring that their department delivers the necessary support to MOIA in achieving its mission of advancing and advocating for the full and active civic, social, political, and economic participation of immigrants and refugees in the City of Los Angeles.
